## PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Ed Meierkort, the USD coaching staff, and Coyote players will give personal instruction on techniques and fundamentals of the game. Each team and their coach will be allotted practice time to work on offensive and defensive schemes.

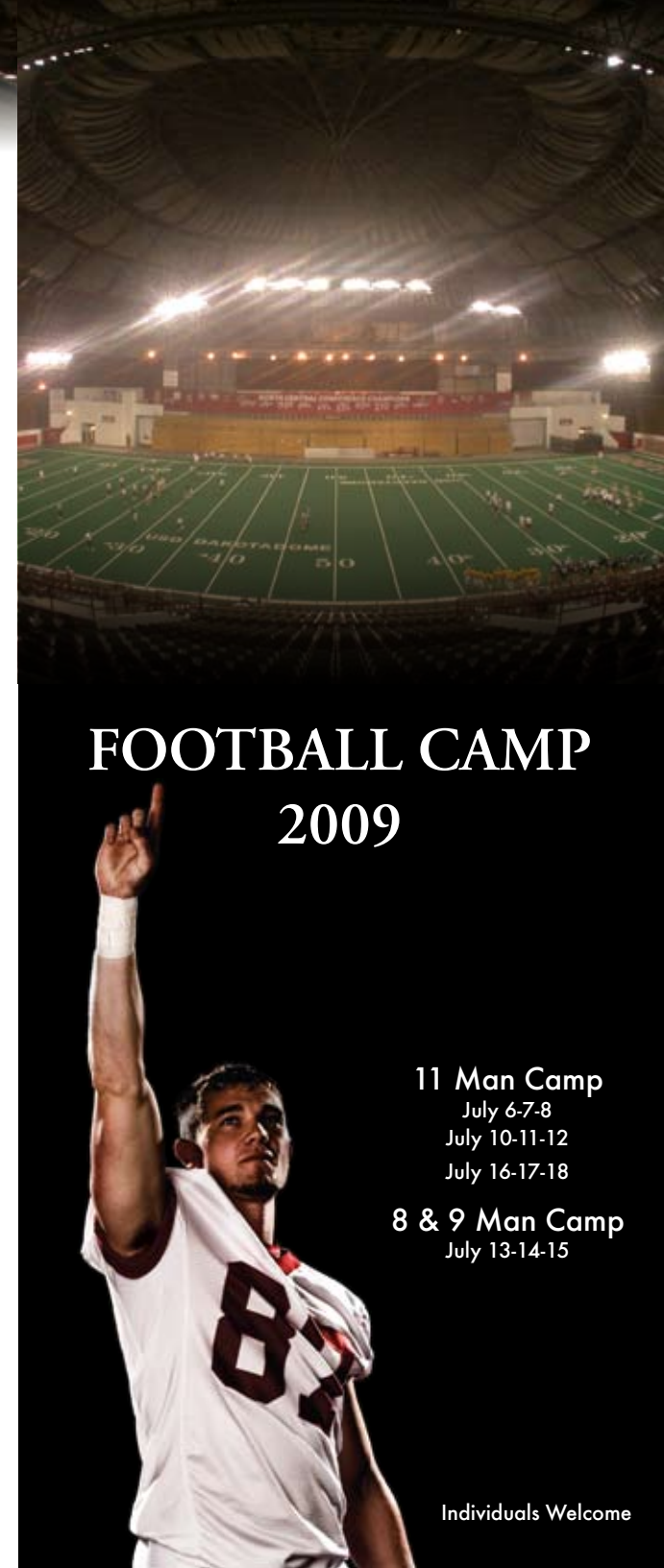
