The USD women's basketball team finished the 2009-10 campaign with a 15-16 overall record, including a 6-6 record in the Great West Conference. The Coyotes faced a difficult schedule -- which included 16 road games and five games against teams that qualified for the NCAA tournament --- during the 2009-10 season.

USD opened the year on Nov. 15 against Wisconsin-Green Bay -- a team ranked in the top 25 for much of the season and qualified for the NCAA tournament -- in a matchup at the Sioux Falls Arena. The Coyotes were within seven points with seven minutes left before the Phoenix pulled away for a 53-40 win. Abby Kinder led USD with 12 points.

USD rebounded with a 71-56 win over Iowa Wesleyan on Nov. 24, thanks to a double-double from Amber Hegge, who had 21 points and 10 rebounds. Sam Mehr had a career-high 17 points in the game for USD.

The Coyotes then played three straight road games, starting with a 65-60 loss at Wichita State on Nov. 29 and then a 77-38 loss at Nebraska -- which ended up winning the Big 12 Conference and earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA tournament.

USD rebounded on Dec. 6 with a thrilling 69-66 win at Santa Clara. Junior Teresa Case hit the game-winning three-pointer with two seconds left to secure the win. Hegge had career-highs 25 points, 15 rebounds and six assists to pace USD in the win.

USD returned home on Dec. 10 to face Black Hills State and earned a 67-49 win, thanks to 16

points from Hegge and 15 from Kinder.

On Dec 13, USD played at Northern Iowa and suffered an 80-60 setback. UNI ended up qualifying for the NCAA tournament after winning the Missouri Valley Conference tournament.

The Coyotes bounced back with a 67-52 win over Mount Marty on Dec. 20, thanks to a career-high 20 points from senior Jasmine Mosley. After a Christmas break, USD resumed action on Dec. 29 at Cal State-Northridge, and fought hard to record a 47-46 win, thanks to a layup by Hegge at the buzzer.

USD suffered road losses at Colorado State and Iowa State to fall to 5-6 on the year, but again came back with a 67-53 win over Seattle. Senior Kara Iverson scored a career-high 20 points in the win.

The Coyotes opened Great West play with a tough 54-51 loss at home to North Dakota on Jan. 16. Two days later, USD fell at SIU Edwardsville, 62-51, which started a six-game road trip for USD.

USD ventured back into GWC play on Jan. 21 at Utah Valley and earned a 65-56 win, thanks 22 points from Hegge and 19 from Annie Roche.

The Coyotes then recorded their most impressive road win of the year on Jan. 23 with a 72-57 win over North Dakota. Hegge had 19 points for USD, while Kinder had 15.

USD lost three tough games on the road in a row, falling at Houston Baptist, Texas-Pan American and Seattle by a combined 17 points, but returned home with a 62-39 rout of Sioux Falls on Feb. 8. Mosley paced USD with 16 points.

2009-10 RECAP

The Coyotes follow that with an impressive 73-49 win over Chicago State as Kinder posted a season-high 20 points.

On Feb 15, USD renewed one of the nation's top rivalries when it played at South Dakota State. USD led for much of the first half but ultimately fell short in a 67-48 loss.

USD came back with two straight wins, beating Utah Valley (68-39) and SIU Edwardsville (63-52) on Feb. 18 and 21, respectively. Hegge had 16 points for USD in each of the wins.

The Coyotes hit the road again and lost at NJIT and Chicago State. USD's next home game was on March 4, and the Coyotes suffered a heartbreaking 57-56 loss to UTPA. USD concluded the regular season with back-to-back home wins -- a 76-45 rout of Houston Baptist on March 6 and a 59-48 win over NJIT on March 7. Kinder had a combined 39 points in those two wins.

USD earned the No. 4 seed in the GWC tournament and faced NJIT for a third time in 15 days on March 11. Thanks to 21 points from Hegge, USD recorded a 57-49 win. The Coyotes' season ended on March 12, however, with a 70-60 loss to UND.

USD had an impressive 10-3 mark at home and is 22-8 in home games in two seasons under Coach Ryon Williams.

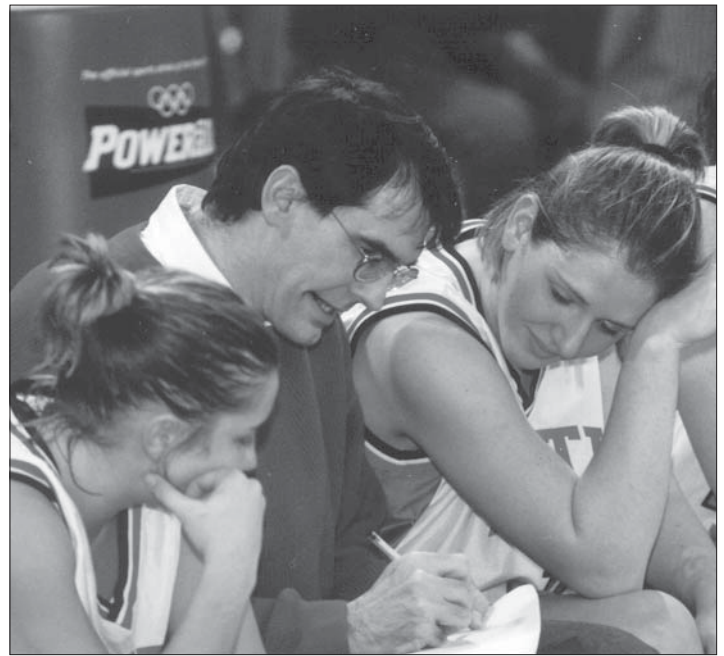

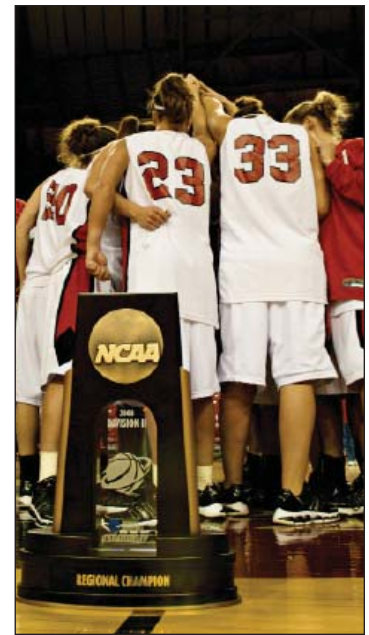
